Our policy is rationally and judiciously to vaccinate the students, faculty members and hospital staff as per the statutory regulations in Priyadarshini Dental College and Hospital.


Preamble

Vaccines are one of the most successful health interventions that bring about significant reductions in infectious diseases and adverse health consequences to improve the quality of life. Health care workers are at high risk for Hepatitis B Viral infection.

Purpose


- For prophylactic immunization against communicable diseases.
- To safeguard the students, teaching and nonteaching faculty members and hospital staff during their clinical work against communicable diseases.

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


Policy

Priyadarshini Dental College and Hospital strictly follows the prophylactic immunization against communicable infectious diseases. By considering the safety of the students, faculty members and hospital staff as per the statutory regulations it has been made mandatory for all students and staffs. All students are hereby to undertake clinical care in the institutions with pre and post immunization requirements.

Immunization Requirements

- Immunization against Hepatitis B is required by law or mandated, as per the instructions of The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University, all candidates selected for admission to first year BDS Degree Courses have to take the Hepatitis-B vaccine before admission and produce a certificate in the principal office.

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

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
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- As per government guidelines for Covid-19 vaccine, all students, faculty members and hospital staffs are instructed to immunize against covid-19 infection.
- Medical history form, which includes an immunization history, shall be given to all new students and must be submitted.
- The vaccination should be immunized in the intervals of 0, 1 and 6 months in first year BDS.
- All faculty members and hospital staffs are directed to take booster dose on time.
- The college send reminders for the students and staff for the immunization dose.
- All female students, faculty members and hospital staffs are directed to immunize Human Papilloma Virus vaccine.

Waiver Exemption

Immunization is mandatory in Priyadarshini Dental College and Hospital, though it will be waived under special circumstances.

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
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
- If a person, had a serious allergic reaction, to a prior dose of vaccine.
 - A student who objects to immunization without a valid medical reason cannot be waived.
 - A waiver on religious grounds may be obtained by giving a written request to the principal.
- This waiver will not apply in case of any emergency or epidemic of disease which is declared by the Ministry of Health, India.

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


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
