
5.3.2 Presence of a student council, its activities related to student welfare and student representation in academic and administrative bodies/committees of the institution.



REPORT ON THE STUDENT COUNCIL ACTIVITIES

Following this, Dr. Vijay Adhith, the student coordinator, announced the results of the student council elections.

This occasion marked a significant moment as we gathered to proudly introduce the newly elected council members who will lead and represent our student body. Dr. B. 
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





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RESPONSIBILITIES




Role of student representatives in Curriculum Committee:

Role of Student representatives in Anti-Ragging Cell


Their role in the Anti-Ragging Cell is to ensure that all students are in a safe environment by raising awareness of anti-ragging policies.


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CLINICAL SOCIETY MEETINGS (CSM)

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


