MINUTES OF MEETING

First governing council meeting of PDCH for the academic year 2008-09 was held at conference hall, Priyadarshini Dental College and Hospital on 11/08/2008 between 11.30 am and 1.00 pm.

The agendas of the meeting were as follows,

- 2. Appointing staffs for all clinical departments
- 3. Defining and approving Vision and Mission statement of PDCH.
- 4. Resource mobilization Policy
- 5. Procuring instruments and equipment for clinical departments.
- 6. Construction of additional space and building for clinical departments.
- 7. Construction of additional building for Boys, Girls hostel and staff quarters.
- 8. Purchasing additional books for library upgradation.
- 9. Any other matter.

The meeting was chaired by Dr. Venkatesan, Principal. The following discussions and decisions were made regarding the agendas.

1.<u>Tie-Up with Government Hospital</u>, Thiruvallur for General Medicine and General Surgery postings for third BDS students.

Principal, proposed to establish a tie-up with the Government Hospital in Thiruvallur to enable the postings of third-year BDS students for General Medicine and General Surgery. Thiru V. G. Raajendran, Chairman, Indira group of educational institutions and Tmt. Indira Raajendran, Managing Director, Indira group of educational institutions and other attendees agreed that this partnership would provide valuable practical experience and exposure for the students. It was decided to form a committee to initiate discussion with the hospital authorities and the government officials to explore the details for the tie-up.

2. Appointing Staffs for Clinical Departments.

The need for appointing staff members for all clinical departments was discussed with Chairman. Dr. Jaya Ranganathan, Professor, Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics, noted that the recruitment process should prioritize qualified and experienced



personnel to ensure the effective functioning of the Departments. A timeline for the recruitment process was proposed and approved by the constitution of selection committee/ staff recruitment board.

3. Defining and approving Vision and Mission statement of PDCH.

The Vision and Mission statement of PDCH was deliberated upon. After a long and detailed discussion, a draft statement was presented by Dr .Mohan. R. S, Reader, Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics and refined based on the input from the other members. The final version given below was unanimously approved, reflecting the institution's commitment to excellence in education and healthcare.

VISION

To evolve as one of the best dental institutions in providing knowledge with excellent learning resources, which will enable students to provide oral health care for the betterment of the society.

MISSION

To provide high quality dental education on par with global standards and to instil moral and ethical values among students.

4. Resource mobilization policy.

Resource mobilization policy was formulated and it was circulated with agenda and it was subjected to discussion. After a long discussion it was approved.

5. Procurement of Instruments and Equipment.

The necessity to procure basic instruments and equipment for the clinical departments was emphasized. Thiru V. G. Raajendran, Chairman, Indira group of educational institutions insisted the staff members to identify the specific requirements, along with potential suppliers and cost estimates.

6. Construction of additional space and building for clinical departments.

The inadequate space for clinical departments was acknowledged, and the exploration of options for construction of additional space, 20% more than the DCI requirement was highlighted. Chairman agreed to conduct a feasibility study to determine the best approach for expanding the clinical areas.

7. Construction of additional building for Boys, Girls hostel and staff quarters.

The urgent requirement for additional hostel facilities for both boys and girls and quarters for staffs was discussed in the meeting. A proposal to initiate the construction of a new building to accommodate the growing need for student and staffs accommodations was well-received, and a task force was assigned to oversee the planning and implementation.

8. Purchasing additional books for library upgradation

The need to enhance the library with additional books, study materials, and modern resources was pointed up by Dr. C. Vijayadhith, Senior lecturer, Department of Orthodontics.

9. Any Other Matter.

A budget allocation for the construction of new building for boys, girls hostel and staff quarters, clinical departments and library upgradation was proposed, with a focus on enriching the academic resources available to the students and faculty and also to provide them with good learning environment.
