Framing of academic calendar

A multi-specialty national dental conference was initiated to be organised in PDCH and the Governing Council unanimously chose Dr. B. Sivapathasundharam as the Organizing Chairman, Dr. R. Veerakumár as the Organizing Secretary and Dr. I. Paavai as the Chairman of the Scientific Committee for the conference, National Dental Summit 2023.

To discuss the feedback report from the stakeholders

Principal shared the feedback received from the students and patients.

Interns requested a stipend of Rs. 1000 per month.

Patients felt that the appointment schedule had to be maintained properly in a systematic order for orderly dental treatment. Principal advised all the staff members to look after it.

Any other matter

A small amount of teaching content with respect to gender sensitisation and sex education, environmental protection were integrated to the 1st year, 2nd year and 3rd year subjects, as suggested by the PDCH curriculum committee

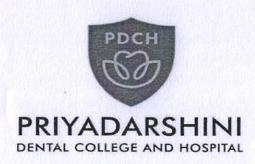

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MINUTES OF MEETING

Staff meeting was held at Principal chamber on 22/05/2023 at 1.00 pm. The agenda of the meeting was on the Strategic planning to enhance the Dental Departments.

Principal Dr. B. Sivapathasundharam welcomed the gathering and gave an introduction.

1. Review of Current State

The current status of Priyadarshini Dental College and Hospital in terms of infrastructure, faculty members, academic programs, research, and student's passing percentage and placement was thoroughly assessed. This involved analysing strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats, to identify areas for improvement and growth.

2. Vision

A collaborative effort was made to define and articulate a clear vision and mission statement for the dental college. The vision statement for 2022-23 was envisioned to evolve as one of the best dental institutions in providing knowledge and excellent learning resources.

3. Mission

The mission was formulated to articulate the core purpose of the vision by providing high quality education on par with global standards and to install moral and ethical values among students.

4. SWOT Analysis

Principal implemented his thought process provoked by one of the faculty development programs by Mr. Perichiappan, as a result of which, A SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats) analysis was conducted to identify internal and external factors affecting the Priyadarshini Dental College. The analysis aimed to leverage strengths, address weaknesses, capitalize on opportunities, and mitigate threats to achieve strategic goals.

5. Strategic Goals and Objectives

Dr. Veera Kumar, Vice Principal mentioned the strategic goals made for the academic year 2021-22 which emphasised on establishing specific strategic goals and objectives for the dental college, addressing areas such as academic excellence, research advancement, community engagement, infrastructure augmentation, faculty development programs and student's success.

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As result of which countable number of MOUs were signed with well-established research institutions.

6. Resource Fund Allocation and Budgeting

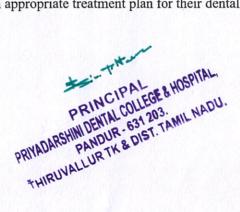
8. Implementation and Monitoring

9. Increasing the Outpatient count

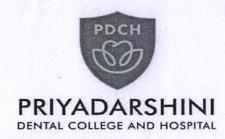
