- To upload in the PDCH website for e-learning.
- Publish best materials in Social media handles like Face book, Instagram, twitter,
   Youtube etc. for the public awareness.

#### General Guidelines to Authors/Creators:

- 1. An author can submit any number of e-learning materials preferably on the subject they are teaching.
- 2. Each e-learning material should cover one topic related to the unit/syllabus.
- 3. The e-learning materials should be submitted in English.
- 4. It is advised to provide the content with examples rather than merely reproducing the bookish information.
- 5. At the end of each content, a summary should be given.
- 6. The content should be grammatically and typographically error free.
- 7. Plagiarism of the content/material should be self-checked.
- 8. Should not violate copy right requirements.

# **Expected Features of E-Content:**

E-content is expected to focus on the following features:

- 1. E-content should encourage the learner in better and an effective manner.
- 2. E-content should attract the attention of the learners.
- 3. E-content should enhance the knowledge level of learners in which it leads to creative thinking

4. E-content should include web links so that it gives the future ideas on the basis of given links and references.

## Procedure for developing E-Content:

- (a) Make a Representation to the Head of the respective department for permission to produce E- content on a particular topic.
- (b) Heads of Departments will authorize development and production of e content with special attention to avoid duplication of production of same topic by different faculty.
- (c) Academic content shall be original content produced by faculty member.
- (d) Multimedia used in e-content like photographs, audio, video, animations etc will be purely original and not copied from copy right protected content available in the web.

### Preparation of Assets and Learning Objects:

- 1. When developing e-content, all teachers shall first formulate a lesson plan to teach a specific objective.
- 2. An "asset" is the smallest indivisible digital unit for transfer of information. For eg, a picture, an audio clip, a video clip or picture with text, audio/text combination, video/text combination, video/audio combination are all assets.
- 3. Learning objects are well planned, sequentially arranged assets which lead a learner to a definite objective or goal.

- (b) Graphics, Audio and Video: Graphics can either be created and edited by specific softwares.

### **E-Classes:**

- 1. Faculties are holding online Classes for their respective subjects.
- 2. They are encouraged to convert these lectures into E-content.
- 3. These can subsequently be made available online and hosted like any other econtent.

# **MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses)**

Faculty are encouraged to create MOOCs.

- PDCH takes all possible steps to teach the faculty and students to create econtent by conducting seminars, workshops and hands on program by having eminent personalities as resource persons.
- Depute the faculty and students to attend such programs as on duty.
- Sponsor the registration fees to attend the advanced programs by faculty members.
- Alloted 500 Sq.ft acoustically designed room with all the necessary gadgets to capture the video and audio for the creation of digital content.
- Procured necessary softwares for digital content creation and editing.
- Appointed a faculty member to upload the created e-content in the institution website under the e-learning tab and to the social media.
- Conduct competition for students in photography, videography, shortfilm making, documentary film making and the like.
