Department of Prosthodontics.


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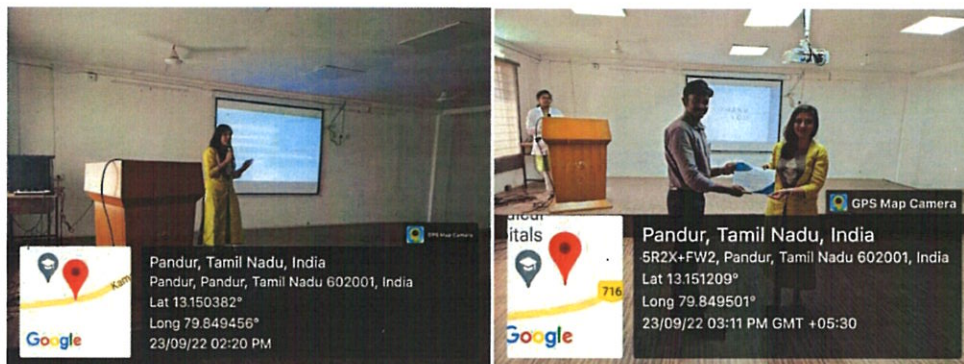
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NAAC ORIENTATION

Faculty from Indira College of Nursing and Indira College of Education are also attended the program. MC: Dr Yamini, Tutor, PDCH.



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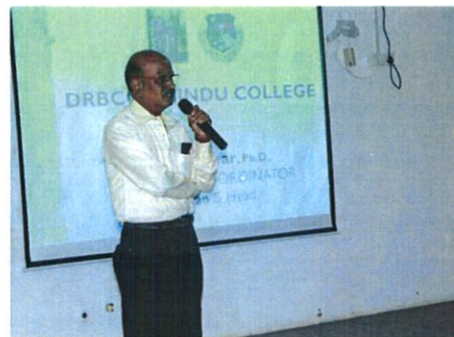
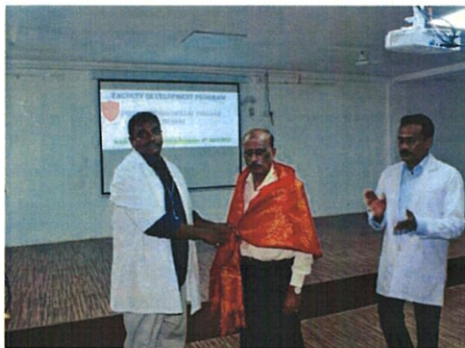
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NAAC PREPARATION

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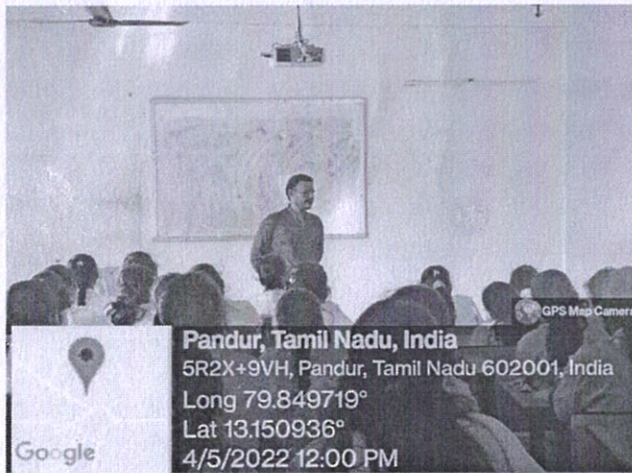

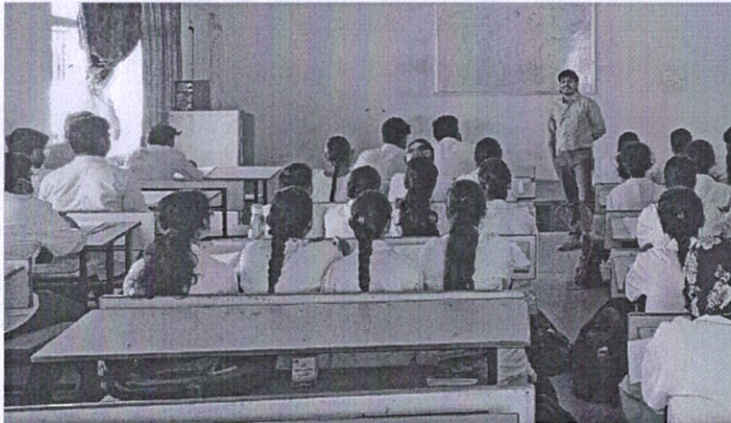
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REPORT ON POINT-OF-CARE DIAGNOSTICS

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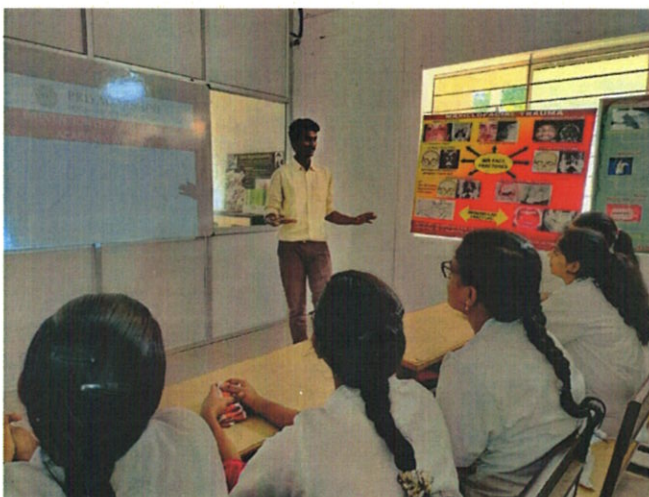

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PREVENTION OF PLAGIARISM IN ACADEMIC WRITING
