University Examinations

Priyadarshini Dental College is one of the best dental institutions when it comes to teaching and learning. It is proved by the fact that the overall pass percentage in the Tamil Nadu Dr. M. G.R. Medical University examinations was 93% with many distinctions and honours for the year 2022-23.

Approval for MDS program

The realization of the dream to start postgraduate and doctoral programs has been made possible by the remarkable infrastructural augmentation and induction of new faculty members by their everenthusiastic management. The approval for the commencement of the Master's degree program in six clinical specialties from the academic year 2023-24 has been granted by the Dental Council of India and The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University.

The excellence in the treatment rendered by the institution is reflected by the increase of patients attending our outpatient department. This also provide an opportunity

Value Added Courses




2022-23 to address ethical issues concerning research and academic activities.

Clinical Society Meetings



Movie and theatre club inauguration



Two such meetings were conducted in the last academic year.


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Anti-ragging Committee

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ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2021-22

Priyadarshini Dental College and Hospital (PDCH) was established in the year 2007 under the aegis of Indira Educational and Charitable Trust with the dynamic leadership of our Chairman Mr. V.G. Raajendran and Managing Director Mrs. Indira Raajendran. It is located at Pandur, in Thiruvallur district, one of the backward districts of Tamil Nadu. This is the one and only dental college caters the rural population of Thiruvallur district for their oral and general health needs.

The institution started with the vision is to evolve as a world class dental college in providing knowledge with excellent learning environment in dentistry, which will enable students to provide oral health care for betterment of the society and the **mission** of the institution is to provide high quality dental education on par with international standards and to instill moral and ethical values among students.

The dental college has 260 electrically operated dental chairs with necessary attachments to treat the patients with oral ailments. All the departments are equipped with latest instruments and equipments as prescribed by Dental Council of India. Two satellite clinics functions nearby villages. A central library with more than 4000 books and subscription for national and international journals is available for the students. There is a separate e-library and audiovisual room is also available.

The institution has organized three programs focused on gender equity sensitization through the ICC and Women Empowerment Cell during the year titled Fostering female representation and representation in digital space, Importance of intersectionality and inclusivity in empowering women, and Importace of career development for women. These initiatives were taken with the primary intention of promoting gender equity among students.

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With the relaxation of lockdown and restrictions by the Government of Tamil Nadu blended teaching was employed to impart knowledge to the students. Internal quality assurance cell was formed. Institutional committees like IEC, Research committee, Publication committee, Institutional Academic Integrity Panel, Internal compliance committee, Mentorship committee and the Clinical society were reconstituted. Dr Sivapathasundharam B, has been appointed as the Principal in the month of January 2022.

MOU with respect to collaborative research, student's observership, faculty exchange was signed between PDCH and Frontier Lifeline Hospitals, Chennai.

For the year of 2021-22, the overall pass percentage in the University examination was 96% with many honors and distinctions. National and International conferences were attended by our faculty members and students. Students won eight Prizes in scientific events. PDCH has conducted four CDE programs. Eleven guest lectures were organized by the institution. The institution is delighted that a selected group of students have been granted approval for ICMR studies.

Clinical Society Meetings, Mentorship Programs, Faculty Improvement Programs, Gender sensitization Programs, Anti cancer Rally, Anti tobacco rally and smile rally in collaboration with Indian Orthodontic Society were conducted. National doctors day, Yoga day, and World environmental day were celebrated. "Times of PDCH", a quarterly news letter carrying the happenings of PDCH was released in the month of April.

The Inter Mentorship Program, **Ignite the inspired**, has successfully conducted 18 programs, benefiting the students by providing them with comprehensive learning opportunities in various aspects of dentistry. Through these programs, students have gained valuable knowledge and practical skills enhancing their understanding and proficiency in the field of dentistry.

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Various camps were conducted in villages in and around Thiruvallur district benefitting a wide array of patients during the year which actively endorse the theme of "Oral Health for rural Hearts".

A specialized Disciplinary committee is in place to monitor and uphold student conduct, ensuring adherence to the college's code of conduct. Additionally, the committee regularly conducts programs aimed at reminding students of their responsibilities and the expected standards of behavior within the college community.

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
During this academic year the online teaching mode was continued for lectures and laboratory practicals. The dental outpatient departments were functional and performed the dental emergency procedures with PPE and strict disinfection and sanitation protocol. Air purifier with HEPA filters were installed in all clinical departments. Special vaccination drive was conducted for the public and more than 80 % of our students got vaccinated for COVID 19. More than 3000 patients were treated in this year in PDCH.

For newly admitted students induction and orientation program and antiragging awareness program were conducted.

The overall pass percentage of this year in the University examinations was over 94% with a considerable number of honors and distinctions.

The Intern Mentorship Committee, - "Ignite the Inspired," successfully conducted four programs in the academic year 2020-21. These programs featured resource persons from various fields of dentistry, aiming to enhance students' understanding of the diverse aspects of dentistry. The committee's efforts were aimed at providing comprehensive mentorship to interns, enriching their learning experiences, and preparing them for their future careers in dentistry.

Faculty members and students have actively participated in numerous National and International conferences, winning several prizes. They have also attended a variety of webinars, and faculty members have delivered guest lectures. The Public Health Dentistry department has conducted several camps, screening and treating a significant number of patients for their dental problems.

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


Committee meetings, ten Clinical Society Meetings and eight mentorship programs were conducted.

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

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
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ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19
