### PAPER PRESENTATION

Paper presentations are limited to one author.

Each presenter will be allocated a maximum of 8 minutes for their presentation, followed by a 2 mindiscussion period.

# **Poster presentation**

The title of the poster must not exceed 100 characters, including spaces.

A maximum of 2 authors can participate in a poster presentation.

Each presenter will be alloted a maximum of 3 min for their presentation, followed a 2 min discussion period .

one best poster will be chosen per session. The author & co - author must be present in person toaccept the award.

#### **MEME & VIDEO**

The theme of the memes & video should either align with the conference theme or focus on promoting dentistry to the general public, patients...

Video Time limit upto Imin.

Videos must be submitted MP4 format with a resolution of 1080p (1920x1080 pixels). Memes must be Submitted in JPG/JPEG format with a resolution of 1080 pixels. Participants are responsible for ensuring the quality & compatibility of their videos & Meme.

The top - selected video & meme will be featured during a dedicated session at the conference.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any copyright issues or conflicts of interest related to the videos. Authors or content creators are responsible for addressing such matters.

# **Table clinic presentation**

Each Table clinic can accommodate between 2 to 4 students.

The presenters will have upto 4 min to present their work, followed by a 2 - 3 min discussion.

Each team will be provided with one Table for display.

One best Table-clinic will be chosen per session. The author and co-author must be present in persontoreceive the award.
